Literature Contest

Categories

Grade 4-6

- 401. Short Story - Limited to 2,000 words
- 402. Poetry - Lyric poem, narrative poem, or sonnet of the last eight lines and no more than fifty lines.

Grade 7-9

- 701. Short Story - Limited to 2,000 words
- 702. Poetry - Lyric poem, narrative poem, or sonnet of the last eight lines and no more than fifty lines.

Directions/Submission Requirements

1. Students may only submit one entry per category
2. Manuscripts entered may not have been published prior to the competition and must be the original work of the author.
3. Entries must be typed, double-spaced, with minimum margins of 1 inch, one side only, on 8-1/2 X 11 inch paper.
4. Entries must be written during the contest year
5. Authors must not be professional writers.

Top right-hand corner of each page, may be attached or printed.

Visual Arts Contest

Categories

Painting – applied using a brush:

- 601. Acrylic or Oil
- 602. Pastels
- 603. Watercolors

- 604. Sculpture - plastic, clay, wire or stone & must weigh less than 50 pounds
- 605. Graphics (defined as the fine and applied arts of representation, decoration, and writing or printing on flat surfaces together with the techniques and crafts associated with them)
- 606. Computer Graphics

Drawing

- 607. Pen and Ink Drawing
- 608. Graphite Pencil Drawing
- 609. Colored Pencil Drawing
- 610. Charcoal Drawing
- 611. Pastel Drawing
- 612. Mixed Media

Directions/Submission Requirements

1. Entries will be judged by categories.
2. Any media or theme may be used.
3. Pastels must be sprayed with a fixative or be under acetate.
4. Entries may not have been previously entered in the GFWC-NC Arts Festival and must have been completed in the last 12 months.
5. 1st place winners will be required to be ready for hanging prior to being forwarded to District Level.
6. Entries may not exceed 30X40 inches, not including matting. 1st place winners will be required to be matted, unless on canvas, prior to being forwarded to District Level. Canvas may have simple frames. OTHERWISE NO GLASS OR FRAMES.
7. Prizes will be awarded in each category.
8. All entries shall be labeled as follows and secured to the back of each entry.

Directions/Submission Requirements

1. Size of entry (without matting) must be at least 8X10 inches and no larger than 16X20 inches. NO FRAMES OR GLASS
2. Photos must be mounted and ready for hanging
3. Only single pictures may be entered. No pairs or groupings.
4. Photos must be properly labeled. Photos must be taken during the contest year (January 1 – December 31, 2010) and may not have been previously submitted.
5. All entries shall be labeled on the back as follows.

Craft Contest

Categories

601. Ceramics: Hand built or wheel thrown only
602. Metal craft: Enameling, sculpture, wire craft, etc
603. Wood: Carving, burning, inlay, etc
604. Paper Craft: Paper mache, paper sculpture, quilling, 3-D elevations, decoupage
605. Decorative painting: Wood, metal, cloth, etc
606. Nature Craft: Dried Flowers, pinecones, painting on rocks, corn shucks, driftwood, shells, etc.
607. Fabric Craft: Quilts, stuffed toys, wall hangings, etc
608. Basic and Creative Stitchery: Needlepoint, embroidery, duplicate stitch, counted cross-stitch, combination of stitches and textures.
609. Crochet/Knitting
610. Dye Craft: Batik, hand or block print, stencil, tie dye, liquid, embroidery
611. Weaving: Loom or hand constructed
612. Mosaics
613. Beadwork

- 614. Jewelry: Any single medium or combination
- 615. Glass Craft: includes stained glass and painting on glass

Directions/Submission Requirements

- 1. Each entry must never have been exhibited and judged on any level of the GFWC-NC Arts Festival.
- 2. Label entries properly. Each article must be labeled with a 3x5 index card as below. On the Front, under description, include whether the article was made from a pattern or is original. Yarn, ribbon, or light weight string can be used to attach the card to the item or to a safety pin, pinned to the item. DO NOT tape or pin the card directly to the item. Needlework items may be framed under glass.
